- 1. How we collect and use your user information
- (1) The information we collect and use when you use our products or services We will only collect and use your user information for the business functions described in this policy. The purpose of collecting user information is to provide you with products or services. You have the right to choose whether to provide the information, but in most cases, if If you do not provide, we may not be able to provide you with the corresponding services, nor can we respond to the questions you encounter:

When you use our services, you allow us to collect the information you provide to us or necessary to provide you with services, including: network logs, device information, location information and other related information. For the user information we collect, we will use it to provide you with identity verification, security protection, anti-fraud monitoring, archive backup, and customer security services.

During your use of our application services, we will collect the information you actively provide when using the services or generated due to the use of the services in the following ways to provide you with services or optimize our services.

# (2) Exceptions to authorization and consent

Please understand that according to laws and regulations and relevant national standards, we do not need your authorization and consent to collect and use your user information in the following situations:

- 1. Those directly related to national security and national defense security;
- 2. Those directly related to public safety, public health, and major public interests;
- 3. Those directly related to criminal investigation, prosecution, trial and execution of judgments;
- 4. In order to protect your or other personal life, property and other major legitimate rights and interests, but it is difficult to obtain my consent;

# 2. How we use cookies and similar technologies

# (1) Cookies

# (2) Web beacons and pixel tags
